### Criminal Reference Check (CRC):

- Many employers have instituted a CRC with vulnerable sector screening as a requirement for appropriate field placements. The CRC will be required at the beginning of the program. All costs associated with the CRC are the responsibility of the student.
- Note: Students with criminal charges or convictions will be severely limited in placement and/or employment opportunities. Those with criminal charges impending or an uncleared criminal record (criminal convictions must be pardoned, sealed or expunged) are not eligible for a field placement experience.

### Health Requirement:

- The confidential Communicable Disease Surveillance (CDS) form must be completed and submitted to Student Health Services prior to start of program. Please view the current CDS form and Checklist for requirements (vaccination documentation/proof of immunity to measles, mumps, rubella, varicella, and 2 step TB testing) at <a href="NiagaraCollege.ca/healthservices">NiagaraCollege.ca/healthservices</a>. Influenza, hepatitis B, tetanus diphtheria pertussis vaccinations are recommended.
- All costs associated with vaccinations, and/or verification, are the responsibility of the student. All health requirements must be met or
  a placement will be denied.
- A current Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR level C) and Standard First Aid certification is required. Students are responsible for all
  costs
- Students applying to the ECE program should recognize the physical demands involved in caring for children and may be required to lift up to 22.7 kilograms (50 pounds).
