To be eligible, students must meet ALL criteria (per Canada Summer Jobs):

- be between 15 and 30 years of age at the start of the employment;
- have been registered as full-time students in the previous academic year and intend to return to school on a full-time basis in the next academic year;
- be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the *Immigration and Refugee Protection Act* for the duration of the employment; and
- have a valid Social Insurance Number at the start of employment and be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial or territorial legislation and regulations.

Qualifications - applicant must:

- demonstrate interpersonal skills through respect, caring and sharing
- demonstrate exceptional written and verbal communication skills in Onondaga, Mohawk and/or Cayuga language (for Transcriber/Translator positions) and in English (for all positions);
- possess a strong ability to prioritize workload and work with minimal supervision;
- possess a strong ability to collaborate with peers and advisors in a team project environment; and
- have an informed awareness of the diverse culture and languages of the Six Nations community; and
- commit to participate in additional training or professional development provided through this employment.
