Johann Conrad Weiser 1696 -1760, German, worked as Mohawk Interpreter, Soldier, Local Official, lived with the Mohawks as a youth. Known for his work with the Six Nations

b. Nov. 2- 1696 d. Jul. 13, 1760

The Skirmish in Virginia 1742

Travelled to Onondaga in 1737, Mohawk Country in 1753

Conrad Weiser — his Report of his Journey to Shamokin.

" Shamokin, May 2d, 1744

At a Council held at Philadia., May 12th, 1737.

Conrad Weiser's Report of his Journey to Onondago on the affairs of Virginia, in Obedience to the Orders of the Governor in Council, 13 June, 1743, delivered to the Governor the 1st September

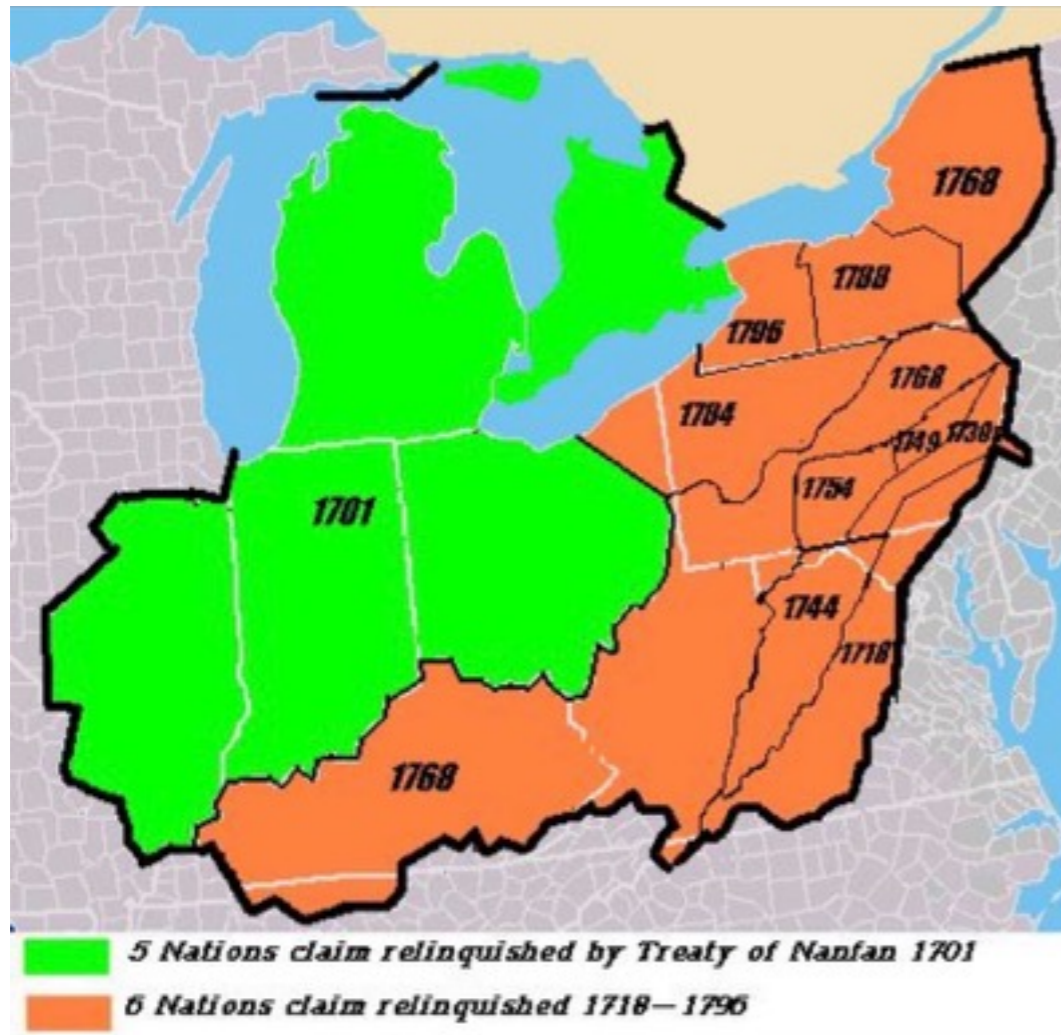

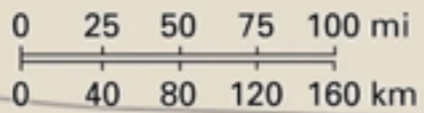
